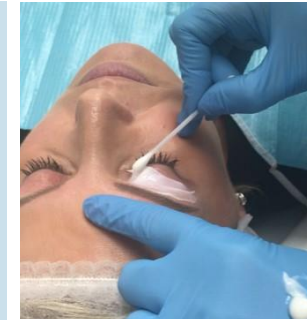

Fibroblast Skin Tightening

Plasma therapy uses the skin's natural healing response to encourage the development of collagen, elastin, and hyaluronic acid in the dermal layer of the skin. The plasma device generates a plasma 'flash' that sublimates the dead epidermal cells at the surface, leaving a tiny carbon crust. The heat from the flash reaches the dermal layer where it triggers fibroblast cells to remodel the skin by secreting collagen, which gives skin its strength, elastin allows it to stretch, whilst hyaluronic acid volumises the skin. Following the procedure there is about 5 days downtime, after which any swelling has subsided, and the carbon crusts have exfoliated. Full remodelling of the skin takes 12 weeks, by which time the skin is tighter and rejuvenated. This non-surgical option carries far less risk compared to conventional surgery, at a fraction of the cost, and a topical anaesthetic ensures as little discomfort as possible. This procedure is extremely effective at reducing hooded or baggy eyelids, Crow's Feet and Smokers' Lines. It is also very useful and effective procedure for the removal of skin tags and moles.

What to expect

During the procedure: Firstly, your practitioner will remove any makeup, and cleanse your skin. The area to be treated will be numbed using a topical anaesthetic and covered with a type of cling film (occluded), to reduce drying and seepage, particularly around the eyes. This will be left for about 20 to 30 minutes before the topical anaesthetic is removed. In some cases, a second number or freeze gel may be applied so that any discomfort is kept to a minimum. The procedure uses a plasma device that creates a small 'flash' close to the surface of the skin sublimating the epidermal cells, leaving a carbon crust. You may feel a slight tingling/burning sensation.



Immediately after the procedure: There will be swelling in the localised area which will develop over the next couple of days. Plasma therapy relies on the skin's natural healing response, which is stimulated by inflammation, so the swelling after the treatment is a positive sign, and one to be encouraged, hence our advice NOT to take antihistamine, or ibuprofen for pain relief as this is also anti-inflammatory.



3 to 5 days after the procedure: The swelling will subside, and carbon crusts begin to exfoliate naturally.

12 weeks after the procedure: You will notice dramatic results from the outset which will develop as the skin remodels over the next 12 weeks. Your practitioner will provide a hydrating balm to ease any discomfort you might experience.

Pre-Treatment Advice

Apart from not wearing any makeup before the treatment, make sure you are not taking any antihistamines in the build up to the treatment. It is important to allow the inflammatory response to take its course as this is the stimulus for skin tightening.

Remember to drink plenty of water to keep your skin hydrated.

If you are having an eyelid lift (blepharoplasty) you must not wear false eyelashes.

Clearly the obvious recommendations to avoid excessive alcohol and smoking will always apply to any aesthetic treatment, as will a daily regime of oral Vitamin C to help collagen synthesis and benefit from its antioxidant properties.

To reduce any risk of hyperpigmentation we recommend that you avoid exposure to direct sunlight or sunbeds in the week before your appointment.

Plasma Lesion Removal

In addition to eyelid lifts, mole and skin tags can be removed quickly and painlessly, without the scarring of conventional surgery.



These images are immediately after treatment. The procedure takes less than 20 minutes once the area has been numbed. The plasma flash also removes keratoses and sunspots, leaving a flat surface of pink skin which heals to match its original skin colour.
